

EXECUTIVE ORDER # 263

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States
and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff
as a Mark of Respect for Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz
of the Pulaski Tri-County Fire Department**

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2008, Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz died in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz served the Pulaski Tri-County Fire Department for over fifty years with distinction and honor; and

WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz; and

WHEREAS, Fire Chief Frank Wichlacz will be laid to rest on Monday, July 28, 2008;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JIM DOYLE, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on **Monday, July 28, 2008**, and ending at sundown on that date.
